Background Seamus Joyce, Managing Director of Joyce Meats Ltd, wanted a handheld delivery system that would provide batch traceability, proof of delivery and eliminate the need for paper dockets. The system had to interface directly with their existing accounting system to remove the need for manual entry of paper dockets. Seamus also wanted the handheld system to cope with the pricing structures already setup in the accounting system.

The Solution Seamus chose ScanScope, the integrated Mobility Solution from Advent along with handheld devices and mobile printers. ScanScope allows routes to be assigned to specific delivery drivers, with standing orders already setup so that the drivers only have to record the batch numbers for traceability. All pricing and stock information is automatically maintained on the handheld device and any stock promotions are highlighted to the drivers.

The customer's signature is captured and an invoice is printed at the customer site. A driver can also create orders for delivery on a future date and record any payments received from customers. At the end of each day all deliveries are uploaded into the accounting system with the appropriate stock adjustments made automatically.

The Benefits Joyce Meats have experienced significant improvements in terms of their pricing control and benefited from increased efficiency combined with the benefit of having complete traceability of their products. The drivers themselves find the system a great aid in terms of previous price checks, full order history and the ability to record and manage customer payments.
